- Obtain permission should they wish to use the resource in a manner that has been restricted;
- Keep the copyright notice intact on all copies of the work;

- Not change the licence terms in any way;
- Not use technology or other means to restrict other licences' lawful use of the work (Liang, 2004, p. 82).

## The 5R Permissions of OER

Retain	<ul> <li>Make and own copies</li> </ul>
Reuse	<ul> <li>Use in a wide range of ways</li> </ul>
Revise	<ul> <li>Adapt, modify, and improve</li> </ul>
Remix	Combine two or more
Redistribute	Share with others

The rights to copy, distribute, display, perform publicly or by digital performance, and to change the format of the material as a verbatim copy (Hofman & West, 2008. p11).




